
**B** Dowels







The same assembly procedure applies to all versions.


We recommend that two people carry out the assembly together.

Protect the product from scratches and other damage while assembling.






Insert the dowels **B** in the crossbars left **L**.





Place the uprights **A** aligned as illustrated.





Mount the crossbars left **L** in the uprights **A**.





Mount the screws **C** with the Allen key **D**. Do not fully tighten the screws.





Insert the dowels **B** into the crossbars right **R**.






Mount the crossbars left **R** onto the uprights **A**.







Insert the screws **C** with the Allen key **D**. Do not fully tighten the screws.




Fully tighten all the screws.





Place the steel shelves **E** on the frame.





Remove the foil from all bumpers on the glass shelves **F**.






Place the glass shelves **F** on the frame.





Fully tighten all the screws.





Mount the safety bracket **G** onto the frame by inserting the screw in the predrilled hole.




