The Workshop Coffee Table by Danish designer Cecilie Manz adds a new perspective to Scandinavian design through a focal emphasis on traditional materiality, craftsmanship and detailing.

Extending the expression of the Workshop Chair that was introduced in the spring of 2017, the Workshop Coffee Table translates the understated elements of Scandinavian craftsmanship into a simple design. Here, the seamless integration of the design's table top and legs echoes the refined design language of the Scandinavian design heritage.

With an appearance that is at once light and elegant, the Workshop Coffee Table fits perfectly into any living room, serving as a traditional coffee table as well as side table. In addition to its obvious function, the design can also be placed in the hallway to act as a counter object.

She is educated from The Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts with additional studies at the University of Art and Design in Helsinki. Manz founded her eponymous studio in Copenhagen in 1998 and has since received numerous awards and honors for her work—amongst others The Crown Prince Couples Cultural Award and the Three-Year Working Grant from the Danish Arts Foundation. Manz has been part of the Muuto family from the very beginning, designing products that include the Workshop Chair, the Airy Coffee Table series, the Compile Shelving System and now, the Workshop Coffee Table.
